Headsets

Our top three models are listed below. All headsets will require a Optiset headset adapter. Wireless headsets also require a lifter.

V100 Wireless Headset (requires adapter and lifter)

This headset can be worn three ways and pairs easily with most business phones. You can talk up to 300 feet away from the base with 10 hours of talk time (up to 120 hours of standby time).



Supra Plus (requires adapter)

This over-the-head set provides all-day comfort and reliability.

Mirage (requires adapter)

This lightweight over-the-ear piece has a noise-canceling microphone and a Quick Disconnect feature that lets you walk away from your phone while wearing your headset.
